### TASTE OF EPIC

The 2008 Epic Cabernet Sauvignon was crafted from a single-vineyard on Howell Mountain, grown by legendary vineyard manager Jim Barbour. The fruit was harvested and vinified by Napa Valley winemaker Celia Welch especially for Epic Roasthouse. This wine was hand-bottled in April 2010 by the Epic Roasthouse staff.

Epic Cabernet Sauvignon shows intense initial aromas of warm raspberries and boysenberries, cocoa powder, a touch of mocha, and shades of vanilla.

## SOMMELIER'S PAGE

### TALLEY VINEYARDS

Talley Vineyards is a family owned and operated winery that specializes in estate grown chardonnay and pinot noir ideally suited for the climate and soils of the Arroyo Grande and Edna Valleys. The Talley's farming history in the area dates to 1948 when Oliver Talley began growing vegetables in the Arroyo Grande Valley. Guided by this legacy and a commitment to long term sustainability, Talley Vineyards focuses on attention to detail in all aspects of farming and winemaking operations. The goal is to produce distinctive wines of consistently high quality that best express the unique character of each of the Talley family's six vineyard sites in the two valleys.

#### **Chardonnay, Arroyo Grande 2008 60**

The 2008 Estate Chardonnay is produced entirely from estate grown chardonnay grapes from the Arroyo, Grande Valley, Rincon Vineyard, Rosemary's Vineyard. It has slightly reticent aromas of citrus and grilled nuts. The flavors feature layers of lemon, wet stone and spicy green apple with a complex and elegant finish.

#### **Chardonnay, *Rincon Vineyard* 2007 80**

This Rincon Vineyard Chardonnay is classically styled with complex aromas of hazelnut, lemon meringue and refreshing notes of wet stone. On the palate, this opulent wine has citrus and creamy custard flavors balanced by bright minerality. The finish is long, dry and lifted by clean acidity.

#### **Chardonnay, *Rosemary's Vineyard* 2007 95**

The Rosemary's Vineyard Chardonnay exhibits aromas of lemon zest and orange blossom, toasted nuts and a touch of oak. On the palate this wine is round with firm acidity, pronounced citrus flavors and a vibrant mineral structure that leads to a long and elegant finish.

#### **Pinot Noir, Edna Valley 2008 68**

A complex bouquet of cranberry, licorice, tobacco, nutmeg, and hints of vanilla. The flavors on the palate are layered with black cherry mulberry, cola, and spice. This medium bodied pinot noir has a plush texture that finishes with soft tannins and balanced acidity.

#### **Pinot Noir, *Rosemary's Vineyard* 2007 117**

The 2007 Rosemary's Vineyard Pinot Noir has subtle and layered aromas of blueberry, sandalwood, cola, and hints of cinnamon and clove. Aeration unveils traditional and elegant pinot noir flavors of raspberry, black cherry, light spice and earth with a plush texture that is Burgundian in style and the hallmark of this vineyard.

#### **Bishop's Peak, Syrah, Edna Valley 2006 36**

Bishop's Peak Wines are handcrafted by Talley Vineyards to capture the unique diversity of the larger Central Coast region. The Edna Valley Syrah shows multiple layers of clove and ripe raspberry with hints of leather, oak, and white pepper in the bouquet. Jammy, ripe black fruits with smoke and cedar give way to an elegant mid-palate and medium tannins. Silky and well balanced, this wine lends itself to many dishes.
